NAATP and SAAS join forces to provide comprehensive salary survey to the addiction treatment field

Lancaster, PA August 2004: The National Association of Addiction Treatment Providers (NAATP) and State Associations of Addiction Services (SAAS) announced today that the survey collection instrument is now available to participate in the 2004 salary survey process. NAATP and SAAS have a long-standing commitment to providing valuable information to organizations that offer addiction treatment and prevention services.

Providing salary survey information to the addiction treatment community has been a key commitment by NAATP, and this year it is joined by SAAS in that effort. The "collection instrument" is **now** available on line at <http://survey.naatp.org> for your completion **by October 1, 2004**. Providers have consistently requested information regarding a wide variety of positions within their organization in helping them to remain market sensitive and market competitive regarding salaries and benefits. In order to provide the most comprehensive and accurate information, we need your participation in this survey.

When you log on to this page we ask that you register as a **new user**. You will need to complete a short registration page and provide a login name (*which is suggested to be your email address*) and a password will then be provided. Organizations can also download a "paper" copy of the survey from this site or from the NAATP web site at www.naatp.org.

The information that you provide will be kept confidential and will only be reported in terms of national and regional averages and ranges. Therefore, we are seeking the most complete response possible in order that the printed results will accurately reflect national and regional activity.

You are encouraged to download a printable copy of the survey and the glossary to review before you begin to complete the survey online. Be sure to use the "glossary" which is provided as a guide in completing the job classification area.
