

Preparing for VBR

Quantity to Quality

Common Fears

- What is on the horizon?
 - "I get the general idea of VBR, but I don't know specifics."
- Financial burden
 - Staff
 - Training
 - IT needs
- Unknown metrics
- Lack of workforce

How To Prepare

- Incorporate/Improve evidence-based practices
- Track outcomes
- Implement quality improvement programs
 - Identify where improvements are needed
 - Develop processes for implementation of improvements
- Offer care management services
- Integrate services for physical and behavioral health

How To Prepare

- Expand the use of technology
 - Quality EMR (documenting, data access and monitoring, reporting, integration with other systems)
 - Streamline internal processes to create efficiency
- Develop partnerships (to ensure patients needs are met)
 - Large healthcare systems
 - Other support services
- Improve relationships/collaborate with payors

Other Considerations

Top down effort (need support of entire organization)
