



1 million COVID deaths
15 million lost a family members

40 million suffer SUD 200,000 SUD deaths annual

# The State of Addiction 2022 The Convergence of Addiction and COVID

# 40.3 million with SUD in 2020-21 It Doubled!

- ≥ 9.3 million misused prescriptions
- ➤ 18.4 million misused illicit drugs
- ➤ 9.5 million misused opioids
- ➤ 6.5 million AUD and illicit drug use disorder

- ➤ 100,000 overdose deaths
  - ➤ Up 31% and approaching 300 per day
  - > Fentanyl is a lethal killer
    - ≥50x stronger than heroin
    - ≥100x stronger than morphine

- > Out of 40.3 million with SUD
- > 28.3 million with AUD
- ➤ 6.5 million drug & alcohol
- > 95,000 people in the US died from effects of alcohol
- ➤ 60% of people report an increase in alcohol use during lockdowns
- Alcohol use among women rose 41%


# Society is Far Less Healthy

- 1.3 million started smoking
- Depression rose 25% to 50%


### The Nexus of SUD & Suicide

- > 75% of suicide deaths involve alcohol or drugs
- > 1.4 million attempts
- > 47,000 died by suicide



Opiates, including heroin and prescription painkillers, are present in 20% of suicide deaths in the U.S.

Rates of suicide in the U.S. are almost four times higher for men than for women.



# Snapshot of the Addiction Treatment Field through NAATP Membership








# Facilities by Revenue Category






# Parent Entities by Revenue Category













# What We're Learning

#### **Patients**




- Need inclusive but standard demographic categories
- Need provider / EMR / payer collaboration on standards

#### Services



- Need to define treatment "dose"
- Need clear documentation of medications received in treatment
- Need to compare telehealth vs. in-person care

#### **Outcomes**



- Need clear definitions for discharge types
- Need to measure SUD remission and re-admission to treatment
- Compare process, satisfaction, PROMs, and biometric data
- Need to implement true Measurement-Based Care
