- Founded Recovery Centers of America, a healthcare network providing affordable, evidence-based addiction treatment and offering a full continuum of care to patients suffering from substance use disorder.

Nikki reported an enjoyable visit. Thank you for hosting her.

As for committee service, we have completed a reorganization of that structure since we last spoke such that most program committees are no longer in place. Previously NAATP was to a degree "board operated" and professional staff was not in place, making program committees necessary to execute operational tasks. That is no longer the case. Program implementation is now performed by professional staff, as is best practice for association operation. Indeed the NAATP board members themselves have stepped back from such involvement as is the professional evolution and maturation of a not-for-profit entity such as NAATP. Having said that, we do have some exception, such as the Membership Committee and the Outcomes and Measures Advisory Committee.

RCA is now represented on the Outcomes and Measures Committee. As for the Membership Committee, I will ask Nikki to reach out to you. Thank you also for your offer of support for a roundtable.
