Scientifically Speaking...

A Complex Bio-Psycho-Social-Spiritual Disease

A chronic disease of the brain

- Disease: primary, chronic, progressive, deadly, and treatable
- Loss of choice is a medical condition

Process in the brain's frontal lobes / neocortex

Not lack of willpower or morality

- With psychological, social, and spiritual components
 - The behavioral piece

How one exists in the world / environment



Addiction Attaches

Either way, it ends badly unless you get help



A Health Care Crisis? How Bad is It?

SUD

- 40 million suffer from SUD
- 120,000 die annually with opiate #s rising dramatically
- 11% get dedicated SUD treatment
 - 100 deaths from drug OD daily and rising

Diabetes

- 29 million suffer from diabetes
- 70,000 die annually
- 85% get dedicated diabetes care
